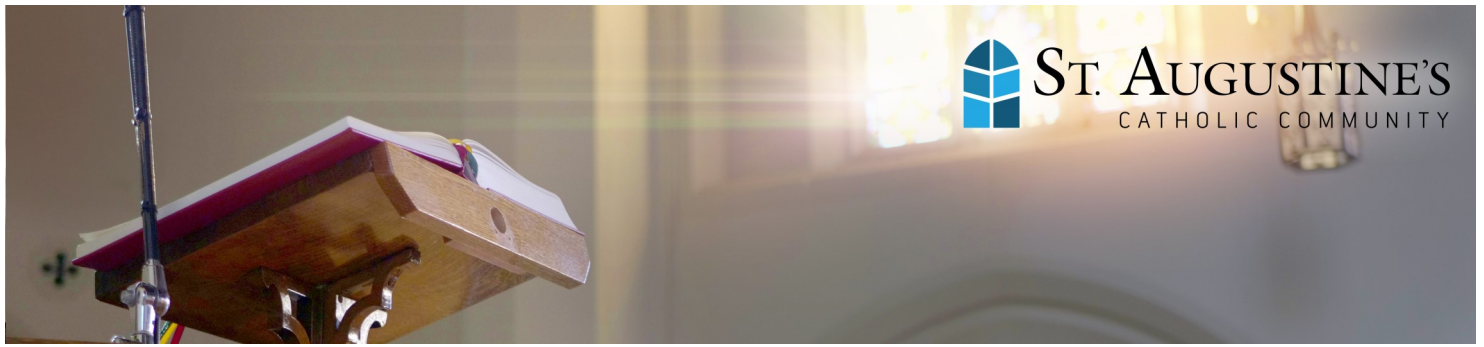

Kindness that has no cost

One of the most beautiful details in this week's Gospel is also one of the quietest: "His heart was moved with pity for them." Before Jesus teaches, heals, or sends anyone out, He notices people. He sees that they are tired, overwhelmed, and carrying more than they can manage on their own. And instead of turning away, He moves toward them.

That still feels very familiar today. People carry a lot quietly. Stress. Loneliness. Worries about the future. The pressure to keep everything together while pretending they are fine. Sometimes the world can leave people feeling exactly as the Gospel describes: troubled and abandoned.

What stands out is that Jesus does not look for perfect people to help. He gathers ordinary people and asks them to bring a little healing, kindness, and hope into the lives around them. And honestly, that is often how real change happens.

Most of us underestimate the impact of small acts of goodness. A thoughtful message. A patient conversation. A warm meal. A moment of understanding instead of judgement. These things may seem small, but they stay with people far longer than we realise.

Then comes that beautiful line from Jesus: "Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give." When you stop and think about it, some of the most important things in our lives were never earned. Love. Mercy. Encouragement. Second chances. Someone once gave those things to us freely.

Maybe that is the invitation this week. Not to do something dramatic, but simply to become a little more aware of the people around us. To notice who might need encouragement, patience, or kindness today. Because sometimes the people who make the biggest difference are simply the ones who choose not to walk past someone hurting without stopping for a moment.

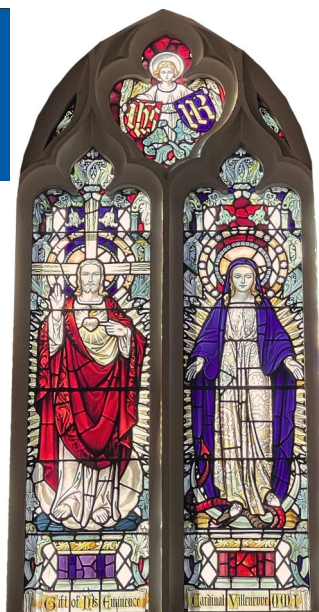
