

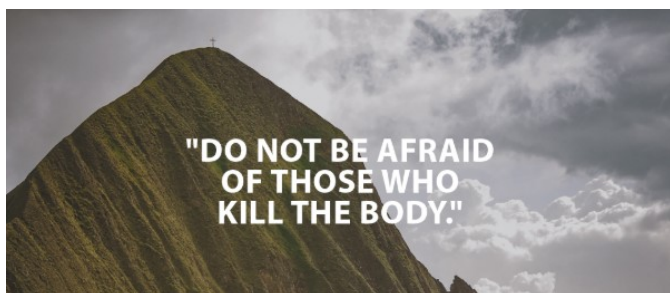

You Matter more than You know!

There is something deeply reassuring about being known. Not just recognised or remembered, but truly known. The kind of knowing that comes from someone paying attention, caring about your struggles, and standing by you even when life gets messy.

That is the image Jesus gives us in this Sunday's Gospel. He reminds His disciples that God knows them completely, right down to the smallest details of their lives. Nothing is overlooked. Nothing is forgotten. In a world that can sometimes make us feel invisible, that is a powerful promise.

It's also a fitting message as we celebrate Father's Day. The best fathers don't just provide. They notice. They know when something is wrong before a word is spoken. They offer encouragement when confidence is low. They create a sense of safety that allows their children to face the world with courage. Their presence quietly says, "You're not alone."

Of course, no earthly father is perfect. Every father, grandfather, godfather, uncle, mentor, and father figure falls short at times. Yet the very best of fatherhood gives us a glimpse of God's heart. A love that remains steady. A love that protects without controlling. A love that believes in us, even when we struggle to believe in ourselves.

That is why Jesus tells us not to be afraid. Fear makes us feel alone, as if every burden is ours to carry. Faith reminds us that we belong to a Father who knows us, loves us, and walks with us. So this week, thank the father figures who helped shape your life. And if you are a father, remember that your greatest gifts are often the simplest ones: your time, attention, presence, and encouragement. Long after everything else is forgotten, people remember how deeply they were loved.

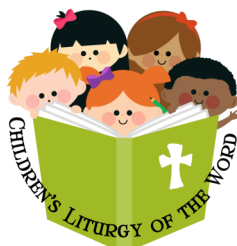

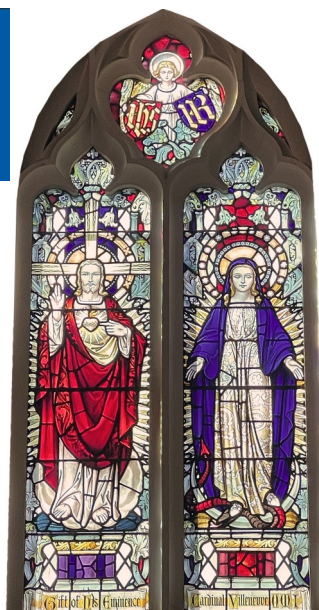
