Come as You are

Life has a way of becoming heavier than we expect. Responsibilities pile up, worries linger, and before long we're carrying more than we were ever meant to carry alone.

That's why Jesus' invitation in this Sunday's Gospel feels so refreshing: "Come to Me, all you who labour and are burdened, and I will give you rest." Notice that He doesn't say, "Come back when you've sorted your life out." He simply says, "Come."

Jesus reminds us that faith isn't about having all the answers or proving how strong we are. It's about trusting God with the things we cannot carry by ourselves. Like a child who knows they are safe in a parent's arms, we're invited to place our confidence in Him.

So perhaps this week, instead of trying to do everything on your own, bring your worries to Jesus. His promise isn't that life will suddenly become easy, but that you will never have to carry it alone. That's the kind of rest every heart longs for.
